2024 TRAILER RACE SERIES

Each driver & mechanic has an obligation to read these rules. All work must be completed on cars before entering pit area.


Trailer Race Tow Vehicles – any stock ½ ton truck, SUV, van, mini van, front wheel drive car, rear wheel drive car or rear wheel drive station wagon. 4WD vehicles will have to disable 4WD. Any year. All vehicles MUST be stock NO modifications. Here is an example of the types of vehicles you can use, but not limited to - Durango, Yukon, Suburban, Tahoe and Expedition, Etc.

Trailer Race Series Rules:

IMPORTANT: AIR BAG SAFETY SYSTEMS (this includes activation charges) must be removed. If air bag or activation charge is deployed during heat you may be disqualified or fined

- 1. Driver's door protection is required. Grater blade, pipe, angle iron, c-channel can be used.
- 2. Must have seat belt & good working brakes.
- 3. Driver must wear long sleeve shirt, long pants and closed toe shoes. Z-90 approved full face helmet, with chinstrap and eye protection are required.
- 4. Stock DOT tires. Snow tires may be used, nothing over 6-ply.
- 5. All glass must be removed, windshields optional. If no windshield we want wire mesh or bars from roof to cowl in front of driver.
- 6. All doors, hoods and trunks must be secured with chain, wire or seat belt.
- 7. Stock gas tanks may be used or may be moved to back seat area.
- 8. 6" x 6" hole must be cut in hood.
- 9. No special front bumpers, must be stock bumpers that came with vehicle.
- 10. Driver's door must be painted white.
- 11. You MUST have a 24" x 24" sign with car number painted on each side of sign and placed upright and center of the roof of the car. MAKE SURE NUMBER IS CLEARLY VISIBLE FOR THE SCOREKEEPERS! If we can't see your number, we can't score you.
- 12. Race will consist of laps determined at driver's meeting.
- 13. Must have secure and safe hitch or good rust free bumper hitch with 2" ball.
- 14. We will work with anyone to make sure they have safe and secure hitches.

- 15. If windshield is not left in vehicle we are recommending wire mesh or bars in front of driver where windshield would have been
- 16. This modification may be used on any vehicle that doesn't have a good hitch: 2"x 2" square tubing up to 36" long can be bolted to frame or rear trunk area



Trailer Rules:

- 1. Example of trailers that you can use: camper trailer, pop up trailer, boat trailer with boat, snowmobile trailer with snowmobile and Sea Doo trailer with Sea Dos. No trailers bigger than 20 ft.
- 2. All glass must be removed.
- 3. All trailers must start with tires on them.
- 4. All trailers must have 2 safety chains. These chains must be no smaller than 3/8", must go up around bumper and/or hitch and through sheet metal.
- 5. If trailer comes off hitch you will be disqualified.
- 6. If you have a trailer with boat, snowmobile or Sea Doo on it and that comes off the trailer you will also be disqualified you must secure item that is on trailer.
- 7. All loose items inside trailer must be removed and swept clean, i.e.: pots, pans, silverware, etc.

General Information:

- 1. All drivers and pit crew members must be able to provide proof of age and picture ID driver's license or state issued photo ID card. This must be done at every event that he/she will be entering pit area no exceptions.
- 2. Unique Motor Sports is not responsible for any damage before, during or after any event for any vehicle that enters into the Trailer Race competition
- 3. Only drivers and pit persons who sign a release will be permitted in pit area.
- 4. Any driver/pit crew not obeying the rules will be disqualified. The driver is responsible for the actions of his/her pit crew in all respects. Unsportsmanlike conduct will result in disqualification. At any time during a UMS event a driver and/or pit person(s) can be asked to leave event for any reason.
- 5. ABSOLUTELY NO ALCOHOL ON GROUNDS. Anyone under the influence of intoxicating beverages or drugs prior to or during the race disqualifies the car and crew of the offending party.
- 6. NO hot rodding in pit area, no passengers riding on vehicle.

- 7. The fair association and UMS will not be held responsible for personal property or damage to any vehicles and trailers entering in the competition at any time.
- 8. At any time during the event if any official rules a car & trailer unsafe it will be disqualified.
- 9. If a vehicle is found illegal there will be no refund of the entry fee or pit passes.
- 10. Must be at event one hour prior to start of show and driver must attend driver's meeting.
- 11. All drivers must sign liability waiver form.
- 12. All injuries must be reported before you leave the event area.
- 13. These rules supersede any and all rules previously used. Rules, payout & dates are subject to change without notice. THE DECISION OF THE JUDGES, SCOREKEEPERS AND OFFICIALS WILL BE FINAL!

At time of registration all drivers and pit personnel must sign a waiver and release of liability and indemnity agreement. These rules will govern all Unique Motor Sports events. All participants must comply with these rules and regulations, it is furthermore agreed that all entries, pit crew, driver, owner, sponsors, safety personnel, law enforcement will comply with these rules. No expressed or implied warranties of any kind. This is a guide set forth for the conduct of the sport and no way a guarantee against injury or death to the spectator, participant or official. Unique Motor Sports has the right to accept or reject any entrees without notice.
