### 2016 RULES

### FULL SIZE STOCK DEMO DERBY

Continue to monitor website for any date or time changes. You can also get the addresses of the fairgrounds off the Upcoming Events page on the website. For Limited Build Demo Derby, Off Road Demo Derby, Figure Eight, or any other events – please visit the website or call.

**FULL SIZE STOCK DEMO DERBY RULES – Each driver & mechanic has an obligation to read these rules. All work must be completed on cars before entering pit area.**

**GET PAID TO PARTICIPATE! There will be two (2) shows but you first have to send in \$25 with your pre-registration to hold your spot – you will get that money back at the end of the show:**

1. Saturday – July 16, 2016 @ 6:30 PM – Mecosta County Fair – Big Rapids, MI – first 20 pre-paid participants in the compact stock or V8 stock demo derby classes will be paid \$100 at the end of the show.
2. Saturday – July 23, 2016 @ 7:00 PM – VanBuren Youth Fair – Hartford, MI – first 20 pre-paid participants in the compact stock or V8 stock demo derby classes will be paid \$200 at the end of the show.

#### **Driver Rules: All Work Must Be Done Before Entering the Pits!!**

1. Pre-entry fee is \$25.00, \$40.00 day of show – with the exception of championship shows; entry includes the car and driver only. Pre-registers must be post marked one week prior to show. Limited to first 50 pre-paid entries. Officials reserve the right to reject or accept any and all registrations. Pit passes will be \$15.00 per person. Anyone under the age of 18 must have a parent signed waiver form.
2. All drivers and pit crew members must be able to provide proof of age and picture ID – driver's license or state issued photo ID card. This must be done at every event that he/she will be entering pit area – no exceptions.
3. Only drivers and pit persons who sign a release form will be permitted in pit area.
4. Any driver/pit crew not obeying the rules will be disqualified. The driver is responsible for the actions of his/her pit crew in all respects. Unsportsmanlike conduct will result in disqualification.
5. Driver must wear long sleeve shirt, long pants and closed toe shoes – fire suit and neck collar is recommended. Safety belts and Z-90 approved full face helmets, with chinstrap and eye protection are required. Safety harnesses are also recommended.
6. ABSOLUTELY NO ALCOHOL ON GROUNDS. Anyone under the influence of intoxicating beverages or drugs prior to or during the race disqualifies the car and crew of the offending party.
7. NO hot rodding in pit area, no passengers riding on vehicle.
8. The fair association and UMS will not be held responsible for personal property at any time.
9. At any time during the event if any official rules a car unsafe it will be disqualified.
10. If a vehicle is found illegal there will be no refund of the entry fee or pit passes.
11. Drivers must attend the drivers meeting held approximately ½ hour before race time.
12. All injuries must be reported before you leave the Demo Derby area.
13. All cars must have brakes to enter.

#### **RULES:**

1. Any 1980 or newer car or station wagon or metric 1977 and newer GM.
2. Stock body, no body shaping or frame shaping.
3. No frame seam welding. No frame shortening.
4. No tilting of frames or cold bending of frames.
5. Rear frame rails may be notched.
6. All body mount bolts and spacers must remain stock with the exception of the front two core support bolts they may be changed with ¾" all rod with a 3" spacer. All rod may go up through hood.
7. Any stock automotive bumper may be used, you may weld 8" from back of bumper to frame.
8. Engine and transmission swaps ok – i.e.: Chevy to Ford. Engine must be mounted on OEM type lower engine mounts.
9. No homemade engine mounts.
10. Engine and transmission may be chained or wired in 4 spots.
11. Headers – ok.
12. Stock transmissions – no bracing.
13. Only engine protector you may have is a distributor protector which cannot be attached to fire wall or cage.

14. After market floor shifter – ok.
15. After market gas pedal – ok.
16. Any 5 bolt rear end may be used – no bracing.
17. You may wire or chain coil springs. Car must maintain bounce.
18. Drive shaft of choice.
19. OEM stock shocks.
20. OEM trailing arms – no reinforcement.
21. OEM tie rods – no reinforcement.
22. OEM steering from steering box to steering wheel must be stock.
23. '03 and newer must use original aluminum cradle.
24. '98 to '02 must use stock Watts suspension.
25. All doors, hood and trunk must be wired or chained in maximum of 6 spots. Two from hood to bumper and 2 from trunk to bumper.
26. Only driver's door may be welded – outside seams only.
27. Inside driver's door must be padded.
28. Cage optional. If using a cage, must be square and free floating. No larger than 6" x 6" square tubing max. May be welded to inside sheet metal up to 6 spots. You may have an up and over roof halo bar. This may be attached to cage, go down to floor, but NOT attached to floor. Rear cage bar can be no more than 6" behind seat.
29. Battery mounted on floor board.
30. Gas tank may be mounted to cage or in center of back seat area. No gas tank protector.
31. Rim and tire - no restriction.
32. No window bars allowed.
33. Must have chain or 9 wire from roof to dash.
34. Mini vans can run in this class if they want – with same rules.

At time of registration all drivers and pit personnel must sign a waiver and release of liability and indemnity agreement. These rules will govern all Unique Motor Sports events. All participants must comply with these rules and regulations, it is furthermore agreed that all entries, pit crew, driver, owner, sponsors, safety personnel, and law enforcement will comply with these rules. No expressed or implied warranties of any kind. This is a guide set forth for the conduct of the sport and no way a guarantee against injury or death to the spectator, participant or official. **Unique Motor Sports has the right to accept or reject any entrees without notice.**
