2017 RULES

OFF ROAD DERBY RULES (STOCK CLASS) i.e.: BUMP N RUN

FRONT WHEEL DRIVE (COMPACT) CLASS

Continue to monitor website for any date or time changes. You can also get the addresses of the fairgrounds off the Upcoming Events page on the website. For regular Demo Derby, Off Road Derby, Figure Eight, or any other events – please visit the website or call.

OFF ROAD DERBY RULES (Stock Class) – Each driver & mechanic has an obligation to read these rules.

This is an entry level – beginner type class of Stock Off Road Derby racing. Any driver may participate in this class. In a regular season once a driver has 3 feature wins in this class – that driver can not complete in this class again until championship.

CHAMPIONSHIP LOCATION – ANYONE MAY ENTER:

UMS “MITTEN MADNESS” OFF ROAD (BUMP N RUN) STATE CHAMPIONSHIP - OTSEGO COUNTY FAIR GROUNDS, GAYLORD, MI – SATURDAY, SEPTEMBER 30, 2017 @ 4:00 PM – NO LIMIT ON FRONT WHEEL DRIVE STOCK CARS.

Driver Rules: All Work Must Be Done Before Entering the Pits!!

1. Pre-entry fee is \$25.00, \$40.00 day of show – with the exception of championship shows; entry includes the car and driver only. Pre-registers must be post marked one week prior to show. Limited to first 18 pre-paid entries. Officials reserve the right to reject or accept any and all registrations. Pit passes will be \$15.00 per person. Anyone under the age of 18 must have a parent signed waiver form.
2. All drivers and pit crew members must be able to provide proof of age and picture ID – driver’s license or state issued photo ID card. This must be done at every event that he/she will be entering pit area – no exceptions.
3. Only drivers and pit persons who sign a release form will be permitted in pit area.
4. Any driver/pit crew not obeying the rules will be disqualified. The driver is responsible for the actions of his/her pit crew in all respects. Unsportsmanlike conduct will result in disqualification.
5. Driver must wear long sleeve shirt, long pants and closed toe shoes – fire suit and neck collar is recommended. Safety belts and Z-90 approved full face helmets, with chinstrap and eye protection are required. Safety harnesses are also recommended.
6. ABSOLUTELY NO ALCOHOL ON GROUNDS. Anyone under the influence of intoxicating beverages or drugs prior to or during the race disqualifies the car and crew of the offending party.
7. NO hot rodding in pit area, no passengers riding on vehicle.
8. The fair association and UMS will not be held responsible for personal property at any time.
9. At any time during the event if any official rules a car unsafe it will be disqualified.
10. If a vehicle is found illegal there will be no refund of the entry fee or pit passes.
11. Drivers must attend the drivers meeting held approximately ½ hour before race time.
12. All injuries must be reported before you leave the Off-Road Derby area.
13. The Off-Road Derby will consist of heats; number of laps and direction will be determined at the driver’s meeting.
14. All cars must have brakes to enter.

RULES -

1. Open to any year - 4 or 6 cylinder front wheel drive car, mini van or station wagon.
2. **This is a stock class.** No skid plates, no radiator protection. No body shaping, folding or shortening.
3. Vehicles must have driver's door protection. Must consist of pipe, grader blade or angle iron. Must be fastened and secure. Must have padding on inside of driver's door.
4. Roll over protection – you must have a minimum of 1 vertical post behind driver's seat. You may also have one behind passenger seat. This must go from floor to ceiling with a minimum of 1/4" x 6" x 6" plate on each end. Must be bolted and welded. Post must be minimum 2" pipe or 2" x 2" square 1/8" tubing. An approved 4 point roll cage is recommended but not required.
5. Only door that may be welded is the driver's door.
6. All other doors, trunk and hood must be wired, chained or bolted shut.
7. Maximum 6 spots on hood and trunk.
8. Chain or wire must go from dash area to roof.
9. No cut tires, no snow tires, no exotic tires. Stock radial tires ONLY. Winter Force or Blizzard Grip tires will be allowed. Decision of UMS staff is final.
10. Battery may be mounted in position of your choice and needs to be secure and covered. If in stock location spray foam may be used to protect battery.
11. Gas tank may remain in stock location or removed to rear seat area of car. Any leakage will lead to disqualification.
12. All glass and loose material must be removed and car must be swept clean. Windshield is optional. If the windshield is removed you must have a chain or 9 wire from roof to dash area.
13. Must have driver's side window net.
14. **You MUST have a 24" x 24" sign with car number painted on each side of sign and placed upright and center of the roof of the car. MAKE SURE NUMBER IS CLEARLY VISIBLE FOR THE SCOREKEEPERS! If we can't see your number, we can't score you.**
15. Air bags must be removed.
16. All vehicles must have five (5) lug nuts and five (5) lug studs on each wheel.
17. You may use stock bumper or you may replace with any 1980 or newer stock automotive bumper. You may bolt this on with up to 8 bolts or lightly weld to the vehicle. If it is over welded or bolted you will be asked to cut. Bumper may be cut down to size and can be no wider than stock factory bumper. Bumper ends must be cut and smashed. No sharp ends. NO homemade bumpers. Questions? Call the office at 616-636-8180.

These rules supersede any and all rules previously used. Rules & dates are subject to change without notice. **THE DECISION OF THE JUDGES, SCOREKEEPERS AND OFFICIALS WILL BE FINAL!**

At time of registration all drivers and pit personnel must sign a waiver and release of liability and indemnity agreement. These rules will govern all Unique Motor Sports events. All participants must comply with these rules and regulations, it is furthermore agreed that all entries, pit crew, driver, owner, sponsors, safety personnel, and law enforcement will comply with these rules. No expressed or implied warranties of any kind. This is a guide set forth for the conduct of the sport and no way a guarantee against injury or death to the spectator, participant or official. **Unique Motor Sports has the right to accept or reject any entries without notice.**

There must be 4 or more participants to have a Stock Off Road Derby heat. Awards and prize money will be given out at each show.

NEW for 2017: All of the rules above apply to our new 4 cyl. ONLY Off Road Derby (Stock Class) – which will be at Barry County Fair, VanBuren Youth Fair & Allegan County Fair. Must have a minimum of seven (7) vehicles for this class to run or it will be combined into the 6 cyl. class.

**** Attention all drivers – for the 2017 season when you pay to participate in two (2) Unique Motor Sports events you will receive the next event that you participate in FREE!! Example if you pay to participate at two (2) events you will receive one (1) event free. This excludes Mid-Season & UMS End of Season Championship events.**
